Welcome back

We want to take this opportunity to say that we are really looking forward to being able to see more children.

All children other than key worker children will attend school Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.

However we understand that you might have concerns about returning to school.

In this booklet we are going to go through some of the changes we've made at the academy, and how drop-off and pick-up are going to work, and what precautions we're taking in school to keep everyone as safe as we can.



Dropping off and picking up your children

To ensure we don't have too many people entering and leaving school at the same time we are staggering the start and end of the day. If you have children in different year groups then we will accept all children in at the same time.

Year Group	Start	Finish
5&6	8.30 - 8.40	2.40
3&4	8.45 - 8.55	2.55
1&2	9.00 - 9.10	3.10
EY	9.15 – 9.25	3.25

Due to the strict timings you must ensure you arrive during your slot. **We may not accept anyone who is late.**



Dropping off and picking up your children

All children need to be brought to the double gates near to Norman Road by one adult only and picked up at the same place (you will see an orange gazebo).

Due to the increase in numbers we will have to close the car park for everyone except disabled users.

Please stand on the markers to help with social distancing and remember to follow the one way system. In through the pedestrian gate next to where the cars come in and out through the pedestrian gate next to where the cars go out.

Adults need to wait whilst children have their temperature taken (staff will also have their temperature taken when they arrive at school).

If all is well they will then enter the building through the Y3/4 door.

Here they will sanitise their hands before entering the building.



Uniform

We want all of our children to wear their uniform as this helps with a feeling of 'normality'. (Key worker children do not need to wear school uniform on a Wednesday)

We do understand that school shoes, for example, may be too small and an unnecessary expense at this time of year so sensible dark shoes/trainers of any type will do.

Guidance says to change and wash clothes immediately when children get home to limit the risk of spreading coronavirus.

Please ensure your child is topped up with sun cream on sunny days.



Lunch, snacks and drinks

School dinners will be provided for children entitled to free school meals and universal dinners. If you require a school dinner the payment is £2.30 a day payable via parentpay.

Lunch box – Please ensure the child's lunch box is wipe able.

Snacks – Please bring a healthy snack for your child.

Drinks – Please bring in a full water bottle for your child.



Social distancing within corridors

A one way system is in place around the school.

All children will enter through the Y3/4 entrance.

Children will leave the building by the rear door and walk round to the double gates.

Tape on the floor around the academy measures out the 2m distance to be maintained.




PPE and Handwashing

Children, and staff, will use hand sanitiser on entry to the building.

Class timetables clearly show regular handwashing times (before and after break/lunch).

PPE will be available for staff who wish to wear it although the government have said this is not needed.

Adults administering first aid or carrying out intimate care will wear PPE.



While this all might seem strange at first, and different from what you are used to at school, we will explain it all to the children and ensure they are comfortable and happy back in school.

The safety of our staff and students is of the utmost importance to us.

We are limiting the number of people on site, including parents. You will not be allowed to enter the school building including the office.
